- Please remember to order your repeat prescriptions in good time. Reception asks for 2 working days to complete prescription requests.

#### **Patient Feedback**

Your feedback is incredibly valuable to us. You may receive a notification, either through the NHS app or via SMS, after you've had an appointment at the surgery. This is part of our **Friends and Family Feedback Test**. The data you provide is completely anonymous, and we regularly review it to ensure we are delivering the best possible care.
